The Flame will pass through the county on the 6th & 7th July 2012, making its way through South-East Essex on the 6th July. Essex County Council, Southend Borough Council and Castle Point Borough Council will invite residents to come to the host locations on these days to welcome the Olympic Flame and celebrate the achievements of the Torch Bearers.



The 70 day Olympic Torch Relay, will start at Land's End, Cornwall on the morning of 19 May 2012.
